The course also includes an ample practical session when participants can assist in the performance of tests for ultrasound clinical and instrumental diagnosis, therapeutic exercise, the use of physical therapies, and the application of elbow braces.

The practical session will also include the direct participation of the attendees, who can thus better learn the various methods of diagnosis and treatment in use.
